

Eiffel Scholarship application guidelines

The Eiffel Scholarship is very highly selective scholarship program which awards the best international students worldwide. This scholarship is issued by the French Ministry of Europe and Foreign affairs and is operated by Campus France.

Eiffel scholarship application – Criteria and guidance :

- 1) Candidates must be admitted to the MiM program and should therefore send their application by email before **November 25th 2021**.
- 2) The candidates must be able to provide valid academic transcripts demonstrating academic excellence.
- 3) Candidates mustn't be older than **25 years old**. More precisely, they should be born before **March 31st 1996**.
- 4) The school or university is in charge of presenting the candidates' applications to Campus France.
- 5) The Eiffel Scholarship assessment board is extremely selective and bases 80% of their evaluation on the **candidates' academic results**. Le Cnam will therefore proceed to a **pre-selection** and selects their best (from an academic perspective) admitted candidates to apply to the Eiffel Scholarship 2022 campaign to make sure that they stand a chance.

Be assured that **candidates who haven't been selected for the Eiffel Scholarship won't, be in case, considered as second best candidates. Le Cnam does not limit the value of its candidates only by their academic results.**

- 6) International students who live in France at the moment of the application are not eligible to the Eiffel Scholarship.
- 7) The Eiffel Scholarship **can't be cumulated** with another scholarship.
- 8) Candidates must apply to this scholarship through **only one** school/institution.
- 9) The results will be released by Campus France during the first week of **April 2022**.
